

Derby Evaluation of Project

The following pictures show the mean grades for the 2 computer-based summative assessments and the final examination for the year the formative assessment was introduced 2004/05 and two years prior. The pictures also show for the same period, the change in the distribution of grades for the computer-based tests (the grades are the average of the first and second computer assessment) and the final examination. The letter grades comprise of F which is a non compensatable fail; MP which is a compensatable fail and D which is the worst pass grade. A grades are first class, B grades are 2:1 level, C grades are 2:2 level and D grades are 3rd class level. The letter grade is based on a non-linear numerical score which runs from zero to 24. A fail grade is awarded for numerical scores between 0 and 5.99. A fail MP grade is awarded for numerical scores between 6 and 9.45. A D is awarded from 9.5 to 10.45 etc.
